# Section 2 Reading Comprehension

#### Cyprus to host EuroBasket 2025 group in Limassol

29 March 2022



Tuesday 29<sup>TH</sup> March, 2022, marked a historic day for Cypriot sports as the FIBA Europe Board of Directors entrusted Cyprus with hosting one of the four groups of EuroBasket 2025. This will be the biggest sporting event ever to take place in Cyprus, with the games to be held at the Spyros Kyprianou Stadium in Limassol. EuroBasket 2025 is set to take place in September, but exact dates have not yet been set for the event.

Latvia, Hungary, Russia and Ukraine submitted bids for the Group Phase and also for the Final Phase of the event. Cyprus and Finland only placed bids to organize the Group phase, and both won their bids. Latvia will host one group phase and the final phase of EuroBasket 2025, the FIBA Europe Board decided. The three countries do not share any borders, but are set to come together to stage European men's basketball's marquee event. For Cyprus, whose member of delegation is Panathinaikos OPAP Athens GM Dimitris Diamantidis, this was their first-ever attempt to host a FIBA event.

According to a press release by the Cyprus Basketball Federation, this decision is the result of many months of intensive work, adding that the federation has had the full support of the government, the Cyprus Sports Organisation, the Limassol Municipality and the Cyprus Olympic Committee.

It is also stressed that the Cyprus national team will compete in EuroBasket 2025 as the host country. This is the first time that the National Team of any team sport in Cyprus will participate in the final phase of a European event. "FIBA Europe's decision to entrust the CBF with the organisation of a group of EuroBasket 2025 shows the very good work that has been done in our country in recent years, as well as the excellent relations that have been built between the CBF and the European federation," the statement concludes.



Qualification for EuroBasket 2025 started in November. All candidate countries submitted their bid dossier in August 2021, after lengthy preparations. In his aim to promote Cyprus and convince the FIBA Europe Board of Directors, the President of the Cyprus Bid Committee for EuroBasket 2025 stated in his address:

"With the sparkle of the clear blue Mediterranean waters, the cosmopolitan lifestyle, world class resorts and a wealth of historical and cultural heritage, Cyprus is undeniably equipped to offer an unforgettable experience to the travelling spectators and the participating teams of FIBA EuroBasket 2025. The most significant sporting event ever to be hosted in the country, will be wholeheartedly embraced by the people of the island who take pride in the beauty of our land, and cherish opportunities to demonstrate their sincere hospitality. The already established commitment and valued support from the highest levels of state and municipal

officials, ensures that organizing EuroBasket 2025 will constitute a priority for the country.

To our nation, however, EuroBasket 2025 is not just about the week the Group Phase games will be played. If we are honoured to be selected as Host Country one of our main goals will be the social legacy that will remain. We aspire that the world class sporting venue to be created will play host to further major sporting events. With a series of campaign side events leading up to and after the main event, we aim for EuroBasket 2025 to act as a springboard for youth basketball engagement, a promotion of fair play and a celebration of intercultural awareness.

It will be an honour and an exciting privilege to welcome you all to the jewel of the Mediterranean, Cyprus!"	!
